When Rebecca Nester's children brought home a flyer they had received at school, she could only help but to feel "completely relieved." The flyer announced changes being made at the Free Clinic of the New River Valley and Mrs. Nester, a Christiansburg resident, had no idea that pediatric patients were being served at the Center. Mrs. Nester recognizes the importance of good oral health, but being dentally uninsured made it very difficult to provide for her children due to the high costs.

On March 27th, her children, Brooklyn, Brayden and Braxton had their teeth cleaned and treated with a cavity preventing sealant. Before coming to the Free Clinic, Mrs. Nester was spending close to \$600 every six months to have her children's teeth cleaned. Mrs. Nester said her family will now be coming to the Community Health Center for all of their dental needs. Mrs. Nester said "The Free Clinic of the New River Valley is such a blessing; it's going to be so convenient for me to bring my children here to receive dental care so that they can continue to have healthy smiles."
